The Paranormal Scale is used to simplify the designation of our findings from an investigation. What we do is after all the evidence has been reviewed we evaluate the results carefully. We then determine which of three categories the evidence leads us. The case is then given a "P" rating of P-1, P-2 or P-3. Below is the scale and explanation of each level.

PARANORMAL SCALE

P-1

NON-EVENT OR ACTIVITY THAT HAS NO PARANORMAL SUGNIFICANTS. IT CAN BE EXPLAINED THROUGH A NATURAL OCCURANCE.

P-2

AN EVENT WHERE ANACDOTAL EVIDENCE DOES SUGGEST THAT UNEXPLAINED ACTIVITY MAY BE PARANORMAL IN NATURE, BUT NO DEFINITIVE EVIDENCE WAS RECORDED. THE NEED FOR FURTHER STUDY IS SUGGESTED.

P-3

AN EVENT WHERE A COMBINATION OF MANY EXAMPLES OF ANACDOTAL EVIDENCE ALONG WITH VERIFIED, VETTED AND DOCUMENTED EVIDENCE HAS BEEN RECORDED. ALL ATTEMPTS TO EXPLAIN THE EVIDENCE HAS FAILED TO PROVE IT TO BE A NATURAL OCCURANCE. PARANORMAL ACTIVITY IS PRESENT.
